Class LKG: "My Little World"

| Subject | Assignment |
|-----------|---|
| English | "Letter Sound Hunt" : Look at 5 things in your kitchen (like a Cup, Spoon, or Box). Say the name out loud and tell your parents the starting sound (e.g., "C" for Cup). |
| Tamil | "உடல் உறுப்புகள்" (Body Parts) : Look in the mirror. Point to your Eyes, Nose, and Ears. Say their names in Tamil (கண், மூக்கு, காது). |
| Maths | "The Counting Bowl" : Take a bowl of small snacks (like grapes, biscuits, or peas). Count from 1 to 10 as you move them one by one into a different bowl. |
| GK | "My Five Senses" : Find something Soft (a pillow), something Loud (a whistle), and something that Smells Sweet (a flower or soap). Tell your parents which part of your body helped you feel/hear/smell it. |
| Colouring | "Rainbow Plate" : On an A4 sheet, draw a big circle (a plate). Use your crayons to fill the plate with your favourite "healthy foods" like a yellow banana, a red apple, and green grapes. |

| Subject | Assignment |
|-----------|---|
| English | "Word Family Tree" : Choose a simple sound like -at (Cat, Mat, Hat) or -an (Fan, Van, Pan). Draw a tree on an A4 sheet. On the leaves, write 4 words that belong to that sound family. |
| Tamil | "உயிரெழுத்துக்கள் படம்" (Vowel Pictures) : Pick 3 Tamil vowels (e.g., அ, ஆ, இ). Find or draw one object for each (அ - அம்மா, ஆ - ஆடு, இ - இலை) and write the letter next to it. |
| Maths | "Number Detective" : Walk around your house. Find and write down: 1. How many fans ? 2. How many clocks ? 3. How many chairs ? (Practice writing numbers 1 to 10). |
| GK | "My Daily Routine" : Draw 3 small boxes. Draw what you do in the Morning (Sun), Afternoon (Bright Sun), and Night (Moon/Stars). Show yourself brushing, eating, or sleeping. |
| Colouring | "The National Flag" : Draw our National Flag. Use your orange, white, and green crayons. Try to stay inside the lines! |

GRADE 1: "My Home, My School"

| Subject | Assignment |
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| Tamil Developing vocabulary and taste senses | "சமையலறை தமிழ்" (Kitchen Tamil): Go to the kitchen. Find 5 things that are Sweet (இனிப்பு) and 5 things that are Sour (புளிப்பு). Write the names in Tamil(A4 Sheet) |
| English Letter-object association | ."Letter Walk": Walk around your house. Find 5 objects that start with the first letter of your name (e.g., if the name is Selvi, find a Spoon, Soap, Shirt). Draw them. |
| Maths Introduction to non-standard measurement | "Hand Span Measure": Use your hand to measure: 1. Your pillow. 2. Your dinner plate. 3. Your school bag. Write how many "hands" long each is. |
| EVS Weather Reporter | Be a Weather Reporter for one week of your holiday. Every morning, look out the window. Draw a symbol in a box for that day. ☀️ for Sunny ☁️ for Cloudy ☔️ for Rainy. Bring your calendar to class |

GRADE 2: "The Junior Investigator"

| Subject | Assignment |
|---|--|
| Tamil Self-awareness and Tamil labeling | "உடல் உறுப்புகள்" (Body Parts): Stand in front of a mirror. Point to your eyes, ears, nose, and mouth and say their Tamil names (கண், காது, மூக்கு, வாய்). Draw a face and label 10 parts. |
| English Color recognition and noun usage. | "Color Hunt": Find 3 Red things, 3 Blue things, and 3 Green things in your house. Write their names in English and frame sentence. |
| Maths "The Coin Collector" | Ask your parents to show you a 1, 2, 5, and 10 rupee coin. Keep a paper over a coin and rub a pencil over it to get the "print." Do this for all four coins in various years. |
| EVS Basics of light and shadows. | "Sunshine Shadow": Stand in the sun in the morning. Look at your shadow. Stand in the same spot in the evening. Is the shadow in the same place? Draw what you saw. |

GRADE 3: "The Home Helper"

| Subject | Assignment |
|---|--|
| Tamil Vocabulary for colors. | "வண்ணங்கள்" (Colors): Find 5 different colored clothes in your house. Write the name of the color and frame sentence in Tamil in your notebook. |
| English Simple grammar through observation | "Action Words": Watch your family members for 10 minutes. List 10 actions they did using "-ing" (e.g., Cooking, Sleeping, Walking) and frame sentence |
| Maths Understanding sequences and patterns. | "Plate Patterns": Use spoons and small bowls to create a pattern on the floor (e.g., 2 spoons, 1 bowl, 2 spoons). Draw the pattern in your notebook. |
| Science Understanding plant textures. | "Leaf Artist": Collect 5 fallen leaves from different plants. Feel them. Which is smooth? Which is rough? Paste them and write "Smooth" or "Rough" next to them. |
| Social Basics of directions and mapping. | "Home Map": Stand in the middle of your house. Which side is the Kitchen? Which side is the Main Door? Draw a simple box map of your rooms. |

GRADE 4: "The Little Scientist"

| Subject | Assignment |
|---|---|
| Tamil Critical thinking and oral tradition. | "விடுகதைகள்" (Riddles): Ask your parents for 5 Tamil riddles. Write the riddle and draw the answer in your notebook. |
| English Reading for information. | "The Label Reader": Take any 5 food item packet. Find and write: 1. Name of the item. 2. Price. 3. Expiry Date. |
| Maths Concept of capacity and volume | "Cup Measurement": How many small cups of water does it take to fill 1 big bottle? Do the experiment and write the number. |
| Science Density and buoyancy. | "Sink or Float": Take a bucket of water. Drop 5 items (Leaf, Stone, Plastic spoon, Key, Coin). Write which ones stayed on top (Float) and which went down (Sink). |
| Social Understanding "Water Source" | Where does the water in your tap come from? Ask your parents (Well, Borewell, or River/Metro). Draw the journey of water to your house. |

GRADE 5: "The Young Manager"

| Subject | Assignment |

| Tamil Listening skills and geography | "செய்தி சேகரிப்பு" (News): Listen to the Tamil news on TV/Radio for 3 days. Write down the names of 3 different districts mentioned in the news. |
| English Basic letter writing format. | "A Letter to My Friend": Write a short 5-line letter to a friend telling them about one fun thing you did during the holidays |
| Maths Real-world money and weight. | "Price List": Go to a small shop (Potti Kadai). Ask the price of 10 items like 1kg Rice, 1kg Sugar, and 1kg Toor Dal. List them in a table. Which is the most expensive? |
| Science Ecology and reforestation. | "Seed Ball Mission": Mix mud and water. Place a seed (Neem or Tamarind) inside a small mud ball. Make 5 balls, dry them, and throw them in an empty space near your home. Write down where you threw them. |
| Social History and lifestyle changes. | "Old vs New": Talk to your grandfather/grandmother. Ask them what they used for washing hair/clothes when they were young. Write how it is different from today. |

GRADE 6:"The Little Observer"

| SUBJECT | ASSIGNMENT |
|---|---|
| Tamil : Connecting with elders & cultural health knowledge. | "பாட்டி வைத்தியம்" : Ask your grandparents or parents for 2 home remedies (using ginger, turmeric, etc.) for a cold or cough. Write them down in Tamil. Draw the ingredients |
| English: Vocabulary building through daily routine. | "My Holiday Diary": Write 5 simple sentences every day about what you did. You must use at least one new adjective (describing word) each day (e.g., delicious lunch, noisy street). |
| Maths The Shape Hunter | Understanding 2D/3D shapes in real objects : Go into your kitchen. Find 5 objects that are cylindrical, 5 that are rectangular, and 5 that are circular (e.g., plates, boxes). List them and measure their length or diameter using a regular scale. |
| Science Nature and Responsibility | Botany basics and understanding food sources : After eating fruits (like lemon, orange, watermelon, or tamarind), make them as seed balls and plant in your area. Write one line about the taste of the fruit (Sour/Sweet) and the process of making a seed ball. |
| Social The Family Tree | History of migration and family roots : Draw a simple family tree going back to your great-grandparents (if names are known). Write the "Native Place" next to each person's name. Mark these places on a rough outline map of Tamil Nadu/India (hand-drawn is fine). |

GRADE 7:"The Home Manager"

| SUBJECT | ASSIGNMENT |
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| Tamil தினசரி செய்திகள் | Bilingual translation skills & current affairs : Cut out one news headline from a Tamil newspaper or write it down from TV news for 5 days. Translate that one headline into English. |
| English Recipe Writer | Technical writing & procedural instructions : Watch your mother or father cook a simple dish . Write the recipe in English using command words (e.g., Chop, Boil, Stir, Serve). |
| Maths Water Auditor | Volume, estimation, and water conservation awareness : Estimate how many buckets of water your family uses in one day (bathing, washing clothes, utensils). If 1 bucket = 20 Litres, calculate the total Litres used in a Prepare the calculation on daily basis. |
| Science Kitchen Chemistry - States of Matter | Heat transfer and states of matter : Observe the boiling of milk or water. Record: 1. Time taken to boil. 2. What happens to the steam? (Place a plate over it carefully). Explain "Evaporation" and "Condensation" using this real-life example. |
| Social Market Survey | Economics and trade/transport : Visit a nearby grocery shop (Maligai kadai) with your parents. Ask the shopkeeper which 3 items are sold the most and where they come from (e.g., Rice from Thanjavur). Write a short note on how food reaches us. Economics and trade/transport. |

GRADE 8:"The Young Analyst"

| SUBJECT | ASSIGNMENT |
|---------------------------------------|---|
| Tamil பழமொழி | Cultural wisdom applied to modern context : Find 5 Tamil proverbs related to agriculture or life (e.g., "அடிக்காற்றில் அம்மியும் பறக்கும்"). Write the meaning and a real-life situation where this proverb applies today. |
| English Movie/Show Critic | Critical thinking and persuasive writing : Watch a movie or a TV show during the break. Write a "Review" (150 words). Discuss the Character you liked the most and Why. Do not just tell the story; give your opinion. |
| Maths The Bill Manager | Data handling, averages, and household budgeting : Collect the last 3 months' Electricity Bills (ask parents for the card or SMS). 1. Create a Bar Graph showing units consumed. 2. Calculate the average cost per month. |
| Science Waste Audit | Ecology, waste management, and sustainability : For 3 days, categorize your house waste into "Biodegradable" (food peels) and "Non-biodegradable" (plastic wrappers). Weigh them (approx) or count the items. Suggest one way your family can reduce plastic use. |
| Social Local Hero Interview | Civics, dignity of labor, and social structures : Interview a community helper (Watchman, Milkman, Sweeper, or Postman). Ask 3 questions: 1. What time do they start work? 2. What is the hardest part of their job? 3. How do they help society? Write a report. (minimum 5 interview reports) |
